Placement Cell: Overall Report of the Session 2024-25

The Placement Cell of the college actively organized and coordinated several programmes during the academic session 2024-25 to create awareness among students regarding career opportunities, enhance their employability skills, and motivate them towards competitive examinations and professional advancement. The initiatives aimed particularly at guiding students from rural backgrounds and empowering girl students through exposure to diverse career paths.

During the session, the following programmes and activities were conducted:

1. Lecture on Career Paths in Economics

Date: 29 August 2024

Total students Benefited: 53

A special lecture was organised on the topic "Career Paths in Economics" to guide students pursuing economics and related subjects. The Associate professor Dr. Satyawan Jatyan provided detailed insights into higher education options, research prospects, government job opportunities, and industry-based roles such as banking, finance, planning, and corporate sectors.

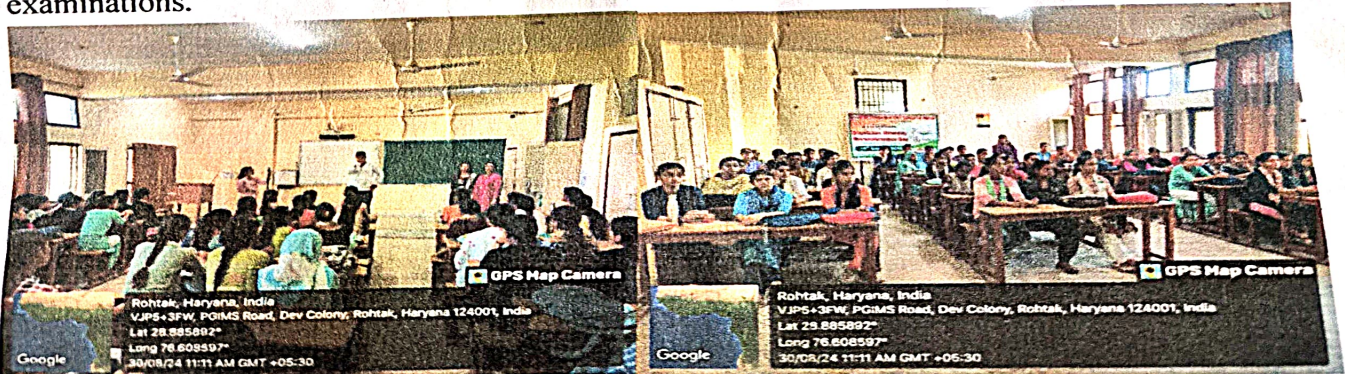

2. Lecture on Career Opportunities After Graduation

The session covered career planning, opportunities in government and private sectors, entrepreneurship options, as well as preparation strategies for competitive examinations.

An expert lecture was organised specially for non-maths students to motivate and prepare them for competitive exams. The session included guidance on syllabi, preparation techniques, time management strategies, and available government and non-government career avenues.


Total Teachers Benefited:
