Steps for observance of 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week and Flag Day 2021'

The following steps are required to be taken for observance of the Communal Harmony Campaign Week & Flag Day 2021:

- (i) Celebration of Communal Harmony Campaign Week & Flag Day 2021 may be observed under the prescribed guidelines of the Government of India pertaining to COVID-19 pandemic issued from time to time.
- (ii) To do campaigning and provide wide publicity for sensitizing teachers, staff, students and public as a whole about the need for fostering communal harmony, National Integration and fraternity. Keeping in view the COVID-19 pandemic, effective use may be made of social media, web based seminars and activities etc.
